- Approximate times and dates you helped community projects and events.
- Times you entered the VFW Voice of Democracy program.
- Names of Veteran members in your family, and how you are related.
- Work and/or job shadowing experience during high school.
- Membership in organizations, including National Honor Society.
- Leadership roles.
- Your future plans and goals.
- Where you are planning (and have been accepted) to attend college or post-secondary training.

Include the following information at the top of the first page of your essay:

- Your Name
- Parent's Name
- Address
- Phone
- Email

If selected, The scholarship money will be paid to the educational institution after a copy of the invoice with the students name and account number is received. Deadline is Oct. 15th.
